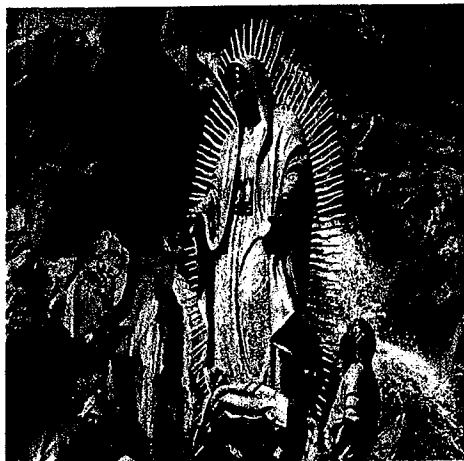

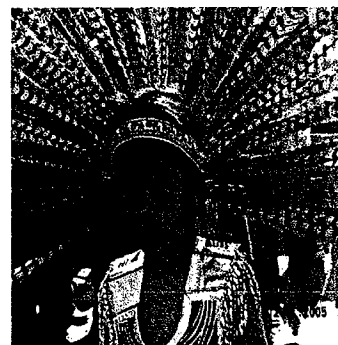
**DAY 1:** Depart from JFK for Mexico City. Afternoon arrival and transfer by deluxe motor coach to your hotel. A couple of hours to relax. Mass at the local church. Dinner and overnight in Mexico City. **(D)**

**DAY 2:** There is a special and beautiful Mass today at the Basilica because of the Feast of the Immaculate Conception. Visit the Church of the Hill, Church of the Well, Monument of the Offerings, the church of the Indians. Pray at the adoration chapel. Visit the Plaza of the Three Cultures and the church where St. Juan Diego was baptized. Dinner and overnight in Mexico City. **(B-D)**



**DAY 3:** This is the feast day of Saint Juan Diego, and the anniversary of our Lady first apparition to him on Tepeyac Hill in Mexico City. After breakfast, we depart for Tulpetlac to have Mass at the Shrine of the fifth apparition, where Juan Diego's uncle, Juan Bernadino, was cured. There is a miraculous well at this site. Visit the Pyramids of the Sun and Moon in Teotihuacan, Free time. Dinner and overnight in Mexico City. **(B-D)**

**DAY 4:** A full day excursion. We will have our Mass at the beautiful Shrine of Our Lady of Ocotlan. Then we proceed to Puebla to see St. Dominic's Church and the Chapel of our Lady of the Rosary that has been called the "Eight Wonder of the World", because of its scalloped gold leaf walls and ceilings. We will also visit the Church of St. Francis of Assisi to see the incorrupt body of St. Sebastian de Aparicio. On the way back, we will return to Mexico City through spectacular mountains with a view of the two most famous peaks covered with eternal snow, considered one of the most beautiful drives in Mexico. Dinner and overnight in Mexico City **(B-D)**.



**DAY 5:** Mass at the Jesuit Holy Family Church, to see and pray at the tomb of Fr. Miguel Agustin Pro, S.J. the Jesuit martyr. We continue to the Plaza of Santo Domingo, the first church built by the Dominicans in 1576. Housed within is the first Rosary shrine in Mexico, Our Lady of the Rosary and a second shrine, our Lady of Covadonga. Then visit the Metropolitan Cathedral, the Tomb of Bishop Zumarraga, and the National Palace. The tour will end at the Basilica of Guadalupe. Dinner and overnight in Mexico City. **(B- L)**



**DAY 6:** Feast of Our Lady of Guadalupe. Main Mass at the Basilica. Millions of people will be present at the Shrine on that day! Free afternoon for prayers, shopping, and sightseeing. "Fare-well dinner" at a local restaurant with Mexican music and dances. Dinner and overnight in Mexico City. **(B-D)**

**DAY 7:** Mass and transfers to airport for our flight back to the USA. **(B)**

Fare does NOT include: Airport taxes and fees (about \$150.00) drinks, travel insurance, tips to your guide and driver (about \$5.00 per day), portorage, items of personal nature. B=Breakfast L=Lunch D=Dinner
