The Bereavement Group meets every other Wednesday at 7:30pm in the convent. Please call 718-375-0668 for the next meeting date.

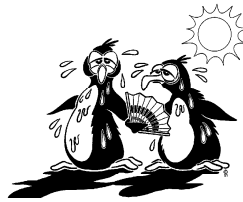
THRIFT SHOP . . .
