

## PERPETUAL ADORATION CHAPEL

***Perpetual Eucharistic Adoration is an age-old Catholic tradition.***

***Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament:***

Quiet time with our Lord, personally present in the exposition of the Holy Eucharist, is a special privilege for our parish. The chapel is open to all visitors, and they come and go freely. But it is not permitted to ever leave the exposed Holy Eucharist alone. In order to ensure this mandate, two special "adorers" must be scheduled for every hour of the 24 hour day, 7 days a week.

*This is a beautiful service to perform.*

***Scheduled Adorers needed:***

With enough people, your service would be required only once a week. Substitute *adorers* can be scheduled when you go on vacation or become ill. Please consider being a part of an age old Catholic tradition and help us with this holy service, as a regular adorer, or as a "substitute."

***Special Volunteers Needed:***

At least four volunteers are needed to maintain the schedule of *adorers* and to recruit new *adorers*. Someone is needed to physically maintain the chapel, i.e. cleaning, watering plants and replacing candles. Please help.

*Our Lady of Grace* is one of a very few parishes to maintain a "Perpetual Adoration Chapel," open to all.

The adorers and the entire church community benefit from the graces that flow from Perpetual Adoration.
