What we do:

Weekly, we discuss the moral and social issues that teenagers face each day, and incorporate Christian values into these talks. Teens are encouraged to share their special gifts and talents for the service of the parish and community, thereby becoming an integral part of it.

ALL TEENS ARE WELCOME. Some of our activities:

Once a month the Teen Group sponsors the 5:00 Mass where we sing, lector, serve, usher and greet parishioners. We assist at the Anointing Mass, Soup Supper, prepare the "Jesse Tree" during Advent, help make Easter baskets and sandwiches for the homeless, as well as Thanksgiving, Christmas, and Easter cards and food baskets for the poor. During Lent, we perform a *meditation play* for the parish. We have FUN while learning new skills and developing our own talents as we do good things for the community.

Adult Volunteers:

Currently, there is only one leader. Please consider spending some time with our developing youth. YOUNG ADULT volunteers are needed, too.

Qualifications:

Must love teens, be a good listener, have patience, and never, ever looked shocked at what you might hear! Being able to remember your own teen years is a plus. Besides the Friday evening meeting, a little extra time is needed during the week to plan activities.
