

**EXTRAORDINARY MINISTERS OF
HOLY COMMUNION**

Ministers bring the Word and the Eucharist to the homebound. They also assist in distributing the Eucharist at Mass on Sunday, Holy Days, and other Parish Liturgies.

Candidates are usually approached by the pastor or present themselves as being interested. They attend a diocesan preparation class followed by an installation ceremony at the Sunday liturgy.

Duties:

Ministers receive a schedule of their assignments for masses.

Communion calls are assigned to Ministers to bring the Eucharist to the homebound.

Qualifications:

Varies according to assignments.

Sensitivity, reverence, and commitment to prayer life are necessary.

As a group, Ministers come together during Advent, in June, and when necessary.
