

USHERS

We ensure that parishioners feel welcome upon entering the church, guide them during communion, and direct them when exiting. Many ushers are members of the Holy Name Society.

**We communicate by telephone as needed,
and meet as a group once a year.**

What we do:

We make possible the smooth movement of parishioners into and out of the church as well as providing any kind of assistance. We warmly welcome parishioners, take up the collection, guide parishioners in an orderly fashion to receive the Eucharist, hand out bulletins as they exit the church, and also hand out other important information.

Stewardship Opportunity:

We need six people at each mass, so altogether, 36 volunteers are needed to cover one weekend of Masses. Each volunteer needs to spend only one hour on Saturday evening or one hour every Sunday, or more during holiday Masses. We also serve at special events such as First Communion and Confirmation, strip the Palm in preparation for Palm Sunday, and distribute it at Mass.

Qualifications:

Be sensible, calm, and be able to follow directives from experienced captains who oversee all activities.

It's important that when serving at Mass, ushers look presentable and respectful in their dress.
